In Trials at Angus Zoeller & FAUN Came Top

Angus Council has purchased its first four FAUN VARIOPRESS 22 cu m body refuse collection vehicles fitted with Zoeller Rotary lifters. "After extensive trials the FAUN VARIOPRESS body came out top," says Willie Whyte, Angus Council Fleet Services Manager, "the deciding factors being the quality of build, payload, service support and competitive pricing." Angus Council have also been operating three ROTOPRESS bodies for the last three years, trouble free, this was also a contributing factor. The bodies are fitted with Zoeller Rotary lifters which brings the fleet of Zoeller lifts at Angus Council to 16. FAUN VIAJET 4



FAUN, Grimma Germany has brought its sweeper innovation to the smallest FAUN sweeper in the VIAJET range. The 4 cu m body is small, nimble and powerful. It has a choice of sweeping concepts, the FAUN air circulation system or mechanical sweeping unit.

The advantage of the FAUN air circulation system is that 70% of the air drawn into the machine remains in circulation with only 30% leaving the machine. This system has lower dust emissions, with lower energy costs and lower vehicle emissions. It is also extremely quiet and highly manoeuvrable. VIAJET 4 is ideal for inner city areas and used as a satellite vehicle it can be emptied into a container ready for collection. The vehicle is mounted onto a standard chassis and has lower running costs than other compact-class sweepers. It is simple to maintain with pneumatic cylinders conveniently placed for maintenance. In addition the dirt collection unit is completely constructed from rust proof material.

FAUN VIAJET 4 with 4 cu m body capacity ideal for satellite systems was launched at IFAT this year.

FAUN COMBIPRESS for Eastleigh



Eastleigh Borough Council have just placed an order for four FAUN COMBIPRESS vehicles to add to their fleet of six FAUN ROTOPRESS vehicles and 10 FAUN VARIOPRESS units already in service.

When Eastleigh Borough Council looked to expand its recycling service the main aim was getting the right supplier to work with them.

David Burton – Head of Direct Services at Eastleigh says, “When procuring vehicles Eastleigh always look beyond purchase price; assessing whole of life costs, after sales support, product quality, and reliability. Using the procurement process to find a manufacturer that will work with us. We wanted a supplier who would listen to us and work with us, tending the vehicles like they were on loan”.

The Council operates alternate weekly collections for domestic waste and dry recyclables, a monthly kerbside glass and a payable garden waste collection scheme. The COMBIPRESS will be used to collect food waste alongside the domestic and dry recyclable waste in a project that the Council expects will help achieve its target of 50% recycling.

Veolia aims to recycle more with 7 ROTOPRESS at West Berkshire

Veolia Environmental Services implemented its new recycling service for West Berkshire Council on 23 June 2008. Residents have been fully supporting the new service with 200 tonnes of recycling collected in the first week (an increase of nearly 23% compared to the average for May).

Veolia Environmental Services General Manager, Keith McGurk said: "By bringing in this new recycling service, people across West Berkshire will be able to recycle even more from home. In turn, this will reduce the amount of waste we send to landfill and increase the recycling rate. We're aiming to recycle more than 40% of household waste over the next three years, increasing to 49%."

The seven FAUN ROTOPRESS 21 cu m body vehicles are mounted onto Mercedes Eonic 26t rear steer chassis with automatic split lifter. They will be operating in the 272 square mile district collecting from approximately 66,000 households.

A ROTOPRESS will be exhibited on stand OA164 at the Recycling and Waste Management Exhibition, NEC Birmingham 16th to 18th September 2008.

Small but Mighty FAUN Micro XL


FAUN Osterholz Germany has launched the FAUN Micro XL 7cu m body refuse collection vehicle. The vehicle may be one of the smallest on the market but it packs a mighty punch collecting waste from inner cities, pedestrian areas and rural areas where access is limited.

High strength materials are used to build a compact solid yet lightweight vehicle. The integrated beam lifter is suitable for all DIN containers up to 1100 litres.

Verdant purchase 20 FAUN VARIOPRESS & 20 Zoeller Rotary Lifters for Stratford contract

Verdant Group plc has purchased 20 FAUN VARIOPRESS and 20 Zoeller Rotary Lifters that began work in August 2008. The waste and recycling contract for Stratford-on-Avon District Council is for seven years, with a seven year extension option from 2015.

The current service comprises weekly collection of residual waste in black sacks, fortnightly kerbside collection of recyclables, and fortnightly collection of green waste. The district's recycling rate for 2005/06 is around 40%, and the council would like to beat the government-mandated target of 45% by 2015.

To reach these targets, Verdant is implementing a three wheeled bin collection scheme for residents: grey for fortnightly kerbside collection of waste; blue for fortnightly kerbside collection of paper, cardboard, tins, glass and all plastics; and a green bin for fortnightly collection of green waste.

The 22 cu m and 27 cu m VARIOPRESS vehicles, all fitted with Zoeller Rotary bin lifts, are already collecting waste and recyclables, and working towards the ambitious targets set by Stratford-on-Avon District Council.
